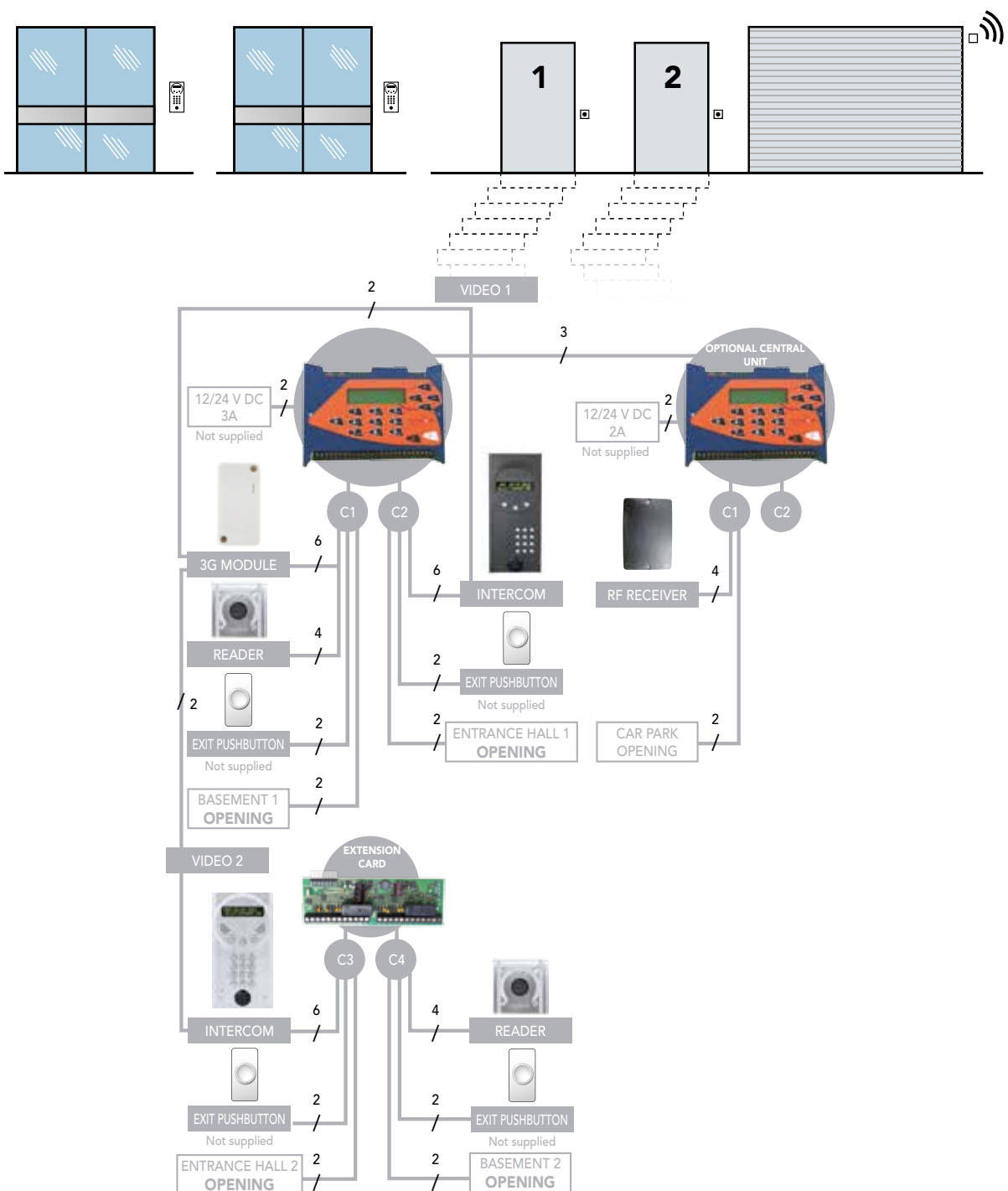


## 2 ENTRANCE HALLS, BASEMENT AND SHARED CAR PARK UP TO 1,000 NAMES



### HOW THE INSTALLATION WORKS

- The residents' badges open an entrance hall and a basement.
  - The remote controls also open the car park.
- Visitors call residents using the intercoms.
- Residents open the entrance hall using the ★ key on their telephone (for example).

This case is typical of an installation in 2 building entrance halls with a shared car park.

### EQUIPMENT REQUIRED

- 2 complete packs with intercom and 1,000-name central unit (cf. p. 33 and p. 35),
- 2 proximity readers (cf. p. 70),
- 2 built-in wall boxes for proximity reader (cf. p. 79),
- 1 extension card (cf. p. 48),
- 1 RF receiver, (cf. p. 62),
- 1 3G block included in the INTRATONE TELECOM package, 3G module(s) supplied on subscription to the contract.

**N.B.** No remote video camera.

Power supply to be wired as close as possible to the central unit.

Max. distance of 100 m between each unit with 0.8 mm twisted cable.
